This year our registration for MK ReEntry opened on December 10th, and by January 1st all 42 spots were filled! I don't ever recall filling up so quickly. It confirms the vital role the program continues to play in serving missionary families who send their MKs to us for 12 life-giving days! In an email from a family serving in West Africa, one mom wrote:



"As we reflect on 2025 and the many ways God has blessed our family, the MK Re-entry program is near the top of our list. We are deeply grateful to you and your staff for the compassionate, empathetic, and thoughtful care you showed our daughter.

We were especially impressed by how genuinely in tune your team is with the realities of TCK life, both the joys and the challenges. You met Anna exactly where she was and equipped her with practical tools that helped her step confidently into a new chapter.

She has just completed her first semester at university in a very demanding program, and she is truly thriving, far beyond anything we could have imagined. We give God all the glory for the way He has set her up to succeed, and we

know that much of her growth can be traced back to those 12 impactful days at the re-entry program. She has applied what she learned with wisdom and grace and now carries a strong, grounded sense of identity as a TCK and as a child of God living in her passport culture.

It is so beautiful and humbling to watch! It brings tears to my eyes as this has been such a heavy burden and fear in our hearts of how our decision to serve cross-culturally would affect our kids long-term. You guys have been a lifesaver and helped Anna embrace her upbringing as she steps into this next chapter of her life.

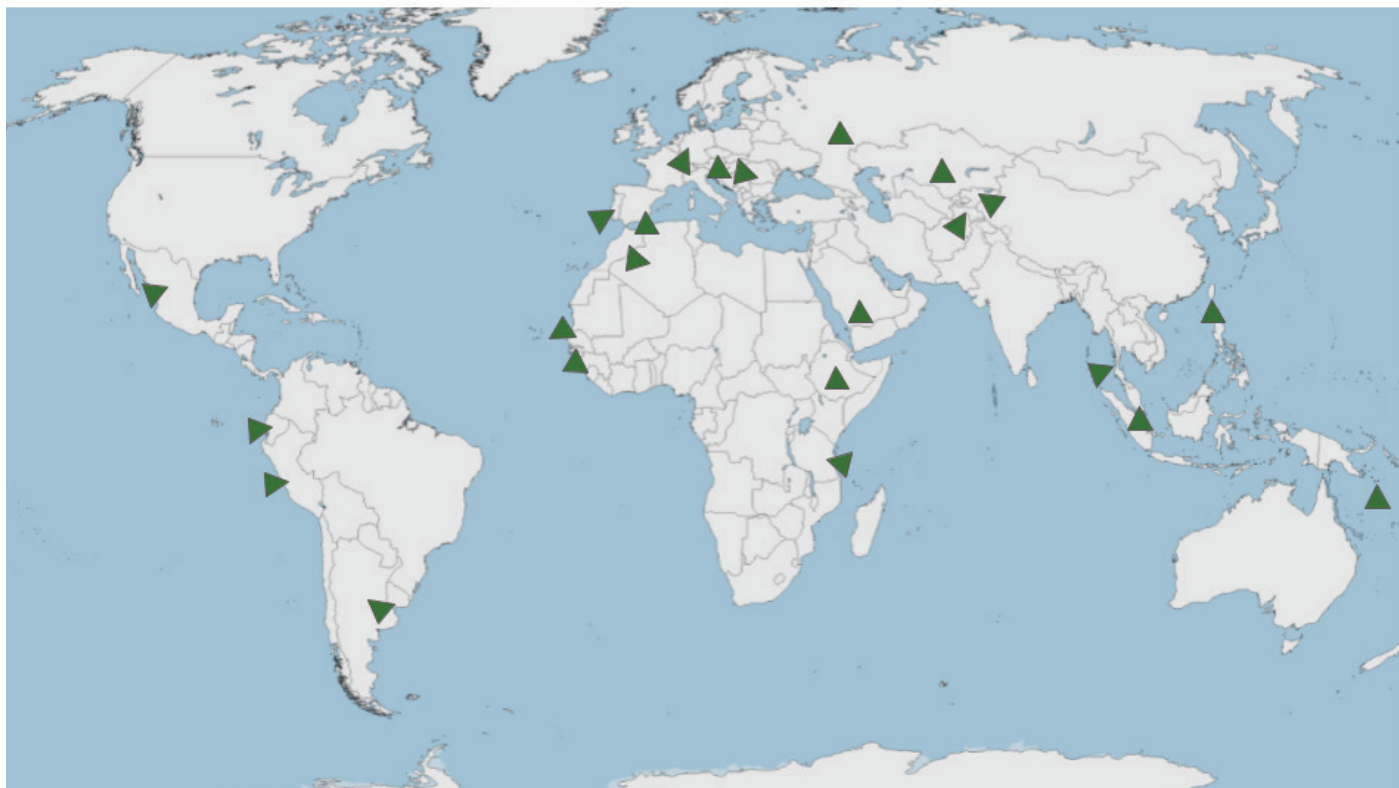
