encourage them that God SEES them and is with them each step of the way. They experience his presence in a tight knit community developed in small groups, class discussions, worship, games, meals, and free time, and they most definitely feel seen!

When you feel safe and you feel seen, healing and growth can begin! That's what so many of the MKs experience when they come to MK ReEntry, just like Sabina two years ago. She knows the value of the program and in her staff application she wrote, "It was only during MK ReEntry I felt like I had my first real experience meeting God through His presence, and over my freshman year, slowly went through the process of stripping away my need for control to make space for him to take over and move in my life." Growth is a lifelong process and we were privileged to be a part of that process for Sabina two years ago and for 43 MKs this year.
